Well-suited for floor covering, solid bamboo flooring has become increasingly popular. Panda Bamboo Flooring is unparalleled in the floor covering industry in terms of hardness, and durability.

Panda Bamboo Flooring has been manufactured to exceed LY/T1573-2000 and GB18580-2001 standards used for Bamboo flooring.

Where Panda Bamboo Flooring is different from other methods of creating Bamboo Flooring the boards are made in a "solid" one piece construction rather than using small pieces and bonding them together either in a horizontal or vertical sections.

Panda Bamboo Flooring does not react to extreme environmental changes, and is subject to less expansion and contraction in comparison to other types of hardwood flooring.

Panda Bamboo Flooring is available in two natural colours; a Light and a Dark colour. Both are made of the same material with the dark colour achieved by simply leaving the material longer in the kiln.
